Preamble

This service will be contractualised by each of the organizations participating in this mutual call for tenders led by the Cooperative of the Humanitarian Logistics Network (RLH Coop).

Presentation of the actors

RLH COOP is a SCIC-SCE (Cooperative Society of Collective Interest - European Cooperative Society) cooperative with variable capital, created on June 25th, 2021.

Its founding members are: ACTED, Action contre la Faim, Handicap International/Humanité & Inclusion, Oxfam Intermón, La Croix Rouge Française, Médecins du Monde, Plan International, Première Urgence Internationale and Solidarités International.

The Cooperative defends the pooling of logistical resources to increase the impact of humanitarian aid and aims to implement a new model introducing a paradigm shift in the operational strategies of NGOs.

This new orientation favors an innovative model, based on the pooling of logistics needs in order to improve the operational efficiency of NGOs.

So far, the Cooperative conducts activities at the headquarters of member NGOs (Europe), as well as in Burkina Faso, the Central African Republic, the Democratic Republic of Congo, and soon in Lebanon and Iraq, where representatives of the cooperative carry out pooling activities.

To respond more efficiently to humanitarian needs and challenges, the RLH Coop has gathered all the computer hardware requirements, i.e., professional computers, accessories, and kits as well as the associated services for Solidarités International, Handicap International, Action Contre la Faim, Médecins du Monde and ACTED.

Created in Lyon in 1982, Handicap International (HI) i.e., Humanity and Inclusion, is an independent and impartial international solidarity organization that intervenes in situations of poverty and exclusion, conflict, and disaster.

Action Contre la Faim (ACF) i.e., Action Against Hunger, founded in 1979, is the leading NGO, recognized for its public utility, to fight hunger in the world. Its mission is to save lives by eliminating hunger through the prevention, detection, and treatment of undernutrition, especially during and after conflict and natural disaster emergencies.

Emergency access and assistance to victims of conflict, natural disasters, and epidemics, extended by early recovery assistance, have been the raison d'être of the humanitarian association SOLIDARITÉS INTERNATIONAL (SI) for over 40 years.

Since 1993, the international solidarity association ACTED has been responding to the humanitarian needs of people in crisis situations and to respect their dignity, while promoting and implementing opportunities for sustainable development, investing in human potential.

Established in 1980, Médecins du Monde (MdM) i.e., Doctors of the World is an international solidarity medical association that fights tirelessly to defend a fair and universal health system. Faced with inertia and indifference, in a world where physical, psychological, political, and institutional violence reigns, Médecins du Monde treats, challenges and challenges, without limits, without ideology or censorship.

Expression of Need

RLH Coop publishes this consultation Ref. HQ/RLH/2022/001 to find one or more entities for the supply of laptops, their accessories and related services for both field-based teams and teams based at Paris and Lyon headquarters for ACF, SI, HI, ACTED and MdM.

RLH Coop therefore expects bidders to be specialized in these trades and experts in the field of computer hardware supply and related services.

Objectives of the commercial consultation

The requirements were made up of five lots:

- Lot 1: 13-inches computers
- Batch 2: 14-inches computers
- Lot 3: 15-inches computers
- Lot 4: computers with processors greater than Intel 7 or Ryzen 7
- Lot 5: refurbished computers

It is authorized to respond to all or part of the lots. Each lot may therefore be assigned to one or more suppliers.
